Getting to the venues

On May 12th 2012 for the Captains' Meeting at Hall 9, Renaissance Room,

Take the MRT East-West (Green) line and alight at Boon Lay MRT Station. Thereafter, take Singapore Bus Service (SBS) bus service no. 199 at the Boon Lay bus interchange located just next to the MRT station. Alight at Hall 8 Bus stop, B09 number 27209.

On May 26th 2012 for the actual competition at Nanyang Auditorium,

Take the MRT East-West (Green) line and alight at Boon Lay MRT Station. Thereafter, take Singapore Bus Service (SBS) bus service no. 179 at the Boon Lay bus interchange located just next to the MRT station. Alight at Opposite Lee Wee Nam Library Bus stop, number 27211.



Walk up the stairs of the overhead bridge, turn left. You will see Mcdonalds/Subway. However, walk along the stretch of corridor, passing by 7-eleven and then Earth Observatory of Singapore.

Keep walking until you see Caffe Express, turn right to enter Nanyang Auditorium.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. NTU Chinese Chess Club is the organiser of this competition.
- 2. The competition date is 26 May 2012. Refer to the schedule for further details.
- 3. The competition venue is at Nanyang Auditorium, Nanyang Technological University.
- 4. Existing students from any Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges, Polytechnics, ITEs and Universities may sign up to represent their institution.
- 5. Competitors may sign up at **captains' meeting in NTU.** The closing date for registration is **12 May 2012.**
- 6. The number of rounds to be played will be set at 7.
- 7. Swiss Perfect will be used to pair up the competitors.
- 8. Latecomers for more than 15 minutes will be deemed to have lost the round.
- 9. Each player shall be given **25** minutes of playing time for <u>team category</u>. No addition of time per step. Players who exceed prescribed timing will forfeit the game.
- 10. Teams are to submit their line-up slips **15** minutes before match start. Should it not be submitted on time or an error is discovered in the submission, the team will be deemed to have forfeited the current round.
- 11. Substitution of players is not allowed once the line-up slip has been submitted.
- 12. Two fouls result in a technical loss.
- 13. Upon ending of a round, competitors are to set back the clock to original position, place back the chess pieces in order, be quiet when leaving, do not disturb the other ongoing games and proceed immediately to the judges to report the results.
- 14. In each round, 1 point will be awarded for a victory, 0.5 for a draw, and 0 for a defeat.
- 15. All players are to be properly attired for the competition. There shall be no sloppy attire such slippers and singlets. <u>Players may wear casual smart attire if their schools allow them to not wear their school uniforms.</u>
- 16. Smoking in the competition venue and the use of electronic devices during a match is strictly prohibited.
- 17. Competition schedules may be pushed forward without prior notice. Competitors are strongly advised not to loiter about.
- 18. By joining this competition, competitors agree to abide by all rules and regulations set down by NTU Chinese Chess Club.
- 19. Judges' decisions are final and no entertainments will be made.
- 20. NTU Chinese Chess Club reserves the right to decide on the winning competitors based on the competition scores.
- 21. NTU Chinese Chess Club reserves all rights to amend, remove, modify and change any part of the competition, rules and regulations without any prior and/or further notice.
- 22. Any breach of the rules and regulation will be dealt with by the Game Director as advised by the judges.
